

# Background



 At the 3rd Ministerial Consultation of the ADD in November 2014 a resolution was made on the initiative of the Philippines to implement CIOP.

• During the ADD SOM of the 4<sup>th</sup> Ministerial Consultation in January 2017 a dedicated workshop as held to discuss the outcomes of the first phase of CIOP and propose an overview for a Phase II.

 ADD Special Technical Workshop in July 2017 had specific breakout sessions for delegations of pairing to sit together and discuss the implementation of piloting of the full suite of CIOP materials once developed.




## Regional Guides






